Registering Bars

The game Bars is a downloadable shareware. Its registered copy costs \$4.95.

The demo version is completely functional except that you can only play at levels 1, 2, 3 and 4. After purchasing the product, you will receive a registration key. The restrictions will disappear and you will be able to play at any level you wish!

After purchasing the product you will receive a registration key. To register it tap on the Menu silkscreen button. Then, select Help, and tap Registration. Finally, enter your Registration Key on the space provided.

The Goal

The goal of the game is to remove all the bars from the screen. You do that by tapping on them. A bar must be detached so that you can remove it. If it overlaps with another bar, you will not be able to remove it and your tap will be a waste of time and a go. Bars pile up in the screen – the higher the level, the faster their speed.

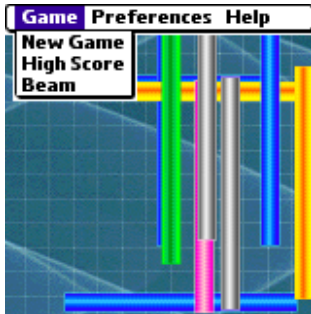
Start – New Game



In the main applications screen of your device, tap the Bars icon. The following picture will appear on the display:

Start – Choose Your Starting Level

The game begins with Level 1 and then gradually moves you to the next levels. If you wish to start from a higher level you should go to **Menu|Game|New game**



The following screen will appear:



Select the level you wish to start from (if the game is not registered you can choose up to 4 level). Tap on **START** to start the game.

Start – The Sound Option

If you wish to enable the sound option while playing, go to **Menu|Preferences** and check its box. Alternatively, disable this box to play the game in silence.



Play Bars

Each level of the game begins with a number of color bars piled in the screen. You have to quickly remove them by tapping on them. The faster you do this the better your time will be and the greater your chances to enter the High Scores Board.



Levels

Bars has 12 levels. The number of bars and the speed at which they appear on the screen increase as the levels ascend.

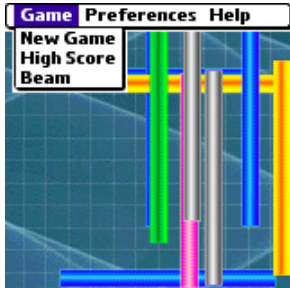
Scoring

Your score depends on the time you've spent to complete the level. The following screen will appear when you finish the game.



Enter your name in the space provided and tap **OK** to continue.

If you want to copy the **Bars** from one Palm device to another you have to choose the option Beam to a friend from **Menu|Game|Beam**.

Once you enter your score the High Scores Board will appear. Here you can see the best scores recorded for each of the levels.
