What is Bookshelf?

Bookshelf is an application to manage books you have, lend and have read. It's very handy when you are in a bookstore or library and try to remember if you already own or have read a certain book.

You can not only record the authors name and title of book but also store infos like category, series, type and price as well as publisher, ISBN, location, number in your collection and even a long note for each book.

If you lend books from public libraries, Bookshelf lets you select the date on which the book has to be returned, when you really did it and set an alarm to remind you.

You're able to filter the list of books by category, series or library and search for a book using the Palm OS build in find function.

- Palm OS 3.5 or better
 - at least 220 kB free memory
 - Advanced Library (sorting, messages)
 - Pim Library (access Datebook, Memopad or ToDo)
 - MemCard Storage Library (access external memory cards)
 - CommonDialogs Library (extended dialogs and note fields)
 - Database Extreme Library (functions for database manipulations)
- The libraries are provided by the installer.

You can move the libraries to flash memory, but before the next update you have to move them back to normal memory. There may be newer version shipped then, which require to overwrite those you have installed.

If you move the libraries to external cards, Bookshelf won't work correct any more!

Register



As long as Bookshelf is not registered, this screen will appear first when starting the app. Tap on "Continue trial" to evaluate longer or on "Enter registration code" to enter your personal registration code.

Please note! Name and Code are case sensitive, so "MartinL" and "martinl" are two different names. When ordering, enter the data of the "Name" field exactly as shown in the order form and when receiving the code from me, do the same.

After launching the application you'll always get to the main screen. There are buttons which give you access to all functions of Bookshelf:

- enter new books (pen and paper)
- to open different lists of books tap on the words:
 - **Series** opens the list which can be filtered by series
 - **Category** opens the list which can be filtered by categories
 - **Library** opens the list which can be filtered by libraries
- open list of books you want (treasure box)
- open list of books you own (book and glasses)
- open list of unread books (books)

Some basic settings and informations are accessible through the menu:



Edit libraries - enter and edit libraries you're using

Papyrus Theme - default colors of Bookshelf

BlueFog Theme - alternative theme

Standard Theme - the standard OS colors

Themes only work on color devices!

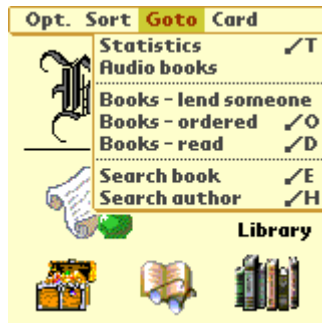

Backup - writes your booklist to external card

Restore - reads your booklist from external card back to main memory

To use these commands, your device must have a SD or Memory Stick slot.

Edit

This is where you enter data for a new book or edit existing ones.

It is strongly recommended to enter the authors name "lastname, firstname" as the database is sorted automatically by this entry.

Note: Please keep in mind, that sorting is case sensitive and a blank as first character is also valid. So "Author", "author" and " Author" are three different names!

To enter author and title of the book you see two lines, but you can write as much as you want. When you reach the end of the second line, a scrollbar pops up automatically.

The next three fields are popups. If you didn't enter your own categories, series or booktypes the lists will be empty. Tap on the icon at the end of each line to edit them (see page 7).

More notes: The decimal separator of the **Price** field has to be a dot, no matter what your local format is. Otherwise calculation of sums doesn't work correct.

The checkboxes show if you want, have ordered, got or read this book. To get descent statistics and lists of your books, it is important to set the checkboxes correct.

If you add a note to a record, a **N** is written automatically in the upper right corner of the screen. The letter **L** marks a book you've lend someone and **S** shows that you've set an alarm for the day a new book will start selling.

The icons on the bottom of the screen mean (from left to right):

- Back to main menu
- New record
- Delete current record
- Go to first record
- Go to previous record
- Go to next record
- Go to last record
- M - opens the "More info" screen (see below)
- L - opens the "Lend books" screen see below)
- N - opens the "Note" window (see below)

You can call more database functions from the menu or with the command stroke:



New - create new record

Delete - delete current record

Duplicate - duplicate the current record. This helps if you have to enter many books which have similar data (like author's name) and works for all fields of the record.

Beam - beams the current record to another Palm powered device. Please keep in mind, that the other person has to have Bookshelf (Pro, SE or the German version) installed too. Data for category and series is **not** transferred. This is no bug as Bookshelf can not know which categories and series the other person has on her / his device.

Print - opens the "Print" screen (see below)



Series - opens the list which can be filtered by series

Statistics - opens the "Statistics" screen (see below)

My books - opens the list of books you own

The **Title** field is read only and shows the name of the current book. You can enter as much as 2040 characters in the **Note** field and a scrollbar is shown as soon as you reach the end of the last line shown.

The paper basket icon erases the **Note** field. The left arrow checks if the field has data, brings you back to the "Edit" screen and writes a **N** to the upper right corner if so.

The **Title** field is read only so you can't edit that data. It's only shown to let you know which book you are working on.

All other fields are normal entry fields.

The icons on the bottom of the screen mean (from left to right):

- go back to "Edit" screen
- goto "More info (2/2)" screen
- goto "Edit audio books" screen

Title is read only again.

Here you can enter when you **bought** and **read** the book and the first day a new book is **sold**. It's possible to write an alarm for the salesdate to your calender: tap on the small clock icon behind the date field and the reminder is set at 12 o'clock on that day. Additionally the **Alarm** checkbox on the upper right corner of the screen is set.

Creat. is filled with the date when this record was created but this may be changed.


The **Rating** popup lets you choose a rating for each book: from + (poor) to +++++ (excellent).

Condition is a large text field. If you reach the last position on line two and write on, a scrollbar pops up to help you navigate easier through the text.

The **sold** data can be erased using the empty sheet icon but only if the alarm day has already passed. The other date fields can be deleted using the "Delete" menu item.

The arrow at the bottom brings you back to the "More info (1/2)" screen.

Here you can enter data for your audio books. To have them shown in the list, at least the **CDs** field must be filled.

The icons at the bottom mean

- back to "More info (1/2)" screen
- goto "Audio books" list

Lending

Title is a read only field and you can't edit the data on this screen. It's shown to make editing easier.

Library opens a popup list. If you didn't enter the libraries you're using, the list will be empty. You can edit them using the menu of the start screen (Option>Edit libraries)

BookID is the number you need to lend the book. In Germany it's called "Signaturnummer", in Great Britain "Shelfmark" and in US "Call Number" or "Classification Number". This field is a normal entry field too.

Due is a date field and when you tap on it the "Select date" dialog pops up. The next two fields are the alarm fields. You can enter a date (first line) and a time (second line) to get a reminder to bring back this book.

Note: if you set several alarms for one day, it is strongly recommended to choose a different time for each record, so you really get a reminder for each book.

When you tap on the clock icon, the alarm is written to your datebook database and the **Alarm** checkbox is set. The entry will have short description, including the title of the book, a duration of 15 minutes and the alarm will start 5 minutes before the time you entered in the field. Since the alarm is written to the standard datebook database this work with any third party Datebook replacement too.

When you return the book to the library, check "back" and select the date. Then tap on the paper button next to the clock icon (the screen will look liked freezed for some seconds) and the fields are empty. For further reference, the "back" date isn't deleted.

When you lend books to friends or relatives, you can enter that data in the last two lines. Check "lend", enter a date in the next field and the name of the person in the "Whom" field.

When you get the book back, delete the field using the empty paper icon.

If at any time you want to delete all entries on this screen, you can can do it using the menu entry "Delete>All fields". Due to technical reasons the screen will freeze during this action.

The icon on the bottom of the screen brings you back to main menu.

Categories

Due to the small screen of the device, the list view shows only a part of the data for author and title. But it should be enough to identify each book clearly.



You get to this list from the main application screen or the menu of the "Edit" screen.

The two rows with checkmarks show the settings you did for "want" / "read" on the Edit screen.

You can filter this list by categories: tap on small triangle on the top right and your list of categories pops up. Choose the one you want, tap on it and the screen only shows books belonging to this category.

This filter is saved and the list will be filtered by it again the next time you open this screen. To see all books again, set the filter to "All".

Use the small up and down arrows or the hardware scroll buttons of your device to scroll through the list.

You can sort your list of books by tapping on the table header **Author** or **Title**.

If your device has a Virtual Graffiti area, you may hide it to show more of your records.

The two icons at the bottom of the screen mean:

- goto main screen (house)
- goto "Edit" screen (arrow)

This screen lets you search for a book or books with similar titles.

Enter the title of a book exactly like it is stored in the database. It's not case sensitive. You don't have to enter the whole title, a part of it will do.

If you need to see more of your data, you can drop down the Virtual Graffiti area on the screen.

The icons mean

- goto main screen (house)
- goto "Edit" screen (arrow)
- search (magnifier)
- clear search phrase (the right arrow)

Search author



This screen works like the one described above, only for authors.

Statistics



You get here from the menu of the main screen or the "Edit" screen. Tap on the arrow at the bottom to get back there.

This screen gives you some infos about the number of books you own, have read, want and have ordered. These informations are calculated in about 1 to 2 seconds each time you open this screen.

To edit an entry, just tap on it and it's opened on the "Edit" screen.

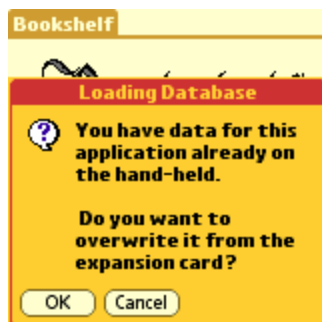


When calling the backup command, you get the chance to change or insert a memory card. This will **not** exit Bookshelf. Tap on "OK" when you're ready and the data is saved.

You will find the file "Buchliste.pdb" in the "/PALM/Bookshelf" folder.

Restore

This command lets you change the card too, before reading the booklist. If data on your device will be overwritten, you'll get the following message:



Only if you're sure that the list on your card is more up to date that the one on your handheld, tap on "OK". Otherwise tap on "Cancel".

Please be careful how you enter the name of the library, as the database is sorted automatically by this field and sorting is case sensitive. So "Library", "library" and " library " are three different names!

"Address" is a large textfield and you can enter as much data as you need.

"Phone" and "Fax" are plain text fields and "Open" is a large field. "ID" lets you store your customer number for this library.

Tapping on the table header **Name** will sort this list alphabetically ascending.

The icons at the bottom work similar to the ones on the main edit screen.

Find function

This is provided by the development IDE and works a bit unusual:



To search Bookshelf's databases you have to open one of the edit screens (books or libraries), tap on the silkscreen find button (bottom right next to the Graffiti area), enter the search phrase (this is not case sensitive) and then tap ok.

The result screen will show the **first** matching record. Tap on that line and the record is opened on the Edit screen.

If you get a "No openDB 0 0" error you didn't start on an edit screen.

As the screenshots show, this function works with FindHack too.

FindHack (shareware) is an enhancement of the build in find function and can be found at <http://fpillet.free.fr> or <http://perso.wanadoo.fr/fpillet/>

BackupBuddy certificate



Bookshelf is "BackupBuddy certified".

This means that Bookshelf's databases are always saved to your PC, re-installed correctly after a hard reset, and when used together with BackupBuddy, saved faster during HotSync.

Known bugs and limitations

- A crash will happen on the Zire22 when you scroll down in a popup list. This happens with all dynamic lists (like categories or series) which are longer than the list window. As these lists are called by a Palm OS function, I can't offer a work around.
- The installer may leave a "Temp Install Data" file on your device. It's safe to delete this file.

Appendix A

Convert your booklist to Palm DB

The following description is for Windows users and only for **the first creation** of a booklist. If you have a Mac, please email me.

If you have a list of books on your desktop machine which you want to get into Bookshelf, save it to a CSV file and name it "books.txt".

The format has to be as follows:

10 rows with **no** header

1. author (lastname, firstname is recommended)
2. title
3. category (or blank)
4. series (or blank)
5. publisher (or blank)
6. ISBN (or blank)
7. want to buy (see note)
8. read (see note)
9. ordered (see note)
10. have it (see note)

Please note! For column 7 to 10 only the words "TRUE" and "FALSE" (without quotes) are valid. Both have to be in upper case!

Your textfile should look similar to this:

```
"author","title","category","series","publisher","isbn","TRUE","FALSE","FALSE","TRUE"
```

Extract the "convert" folder from the Bookshelf download to a temporary folder. Copy your "books.txt" to that folder too and run "makedb.bat" and you'll get a "booklist.pdb" file to install on your device.
