QLaunch v4.1

QLaunch v4.1 is a free upgrade for anyone running v4.0. If you are not running v4.0 yet, then it is a pay upgrade for any pre v4.0 registered users.

All of the following statements about QLaunch v4.0 apply to v4.1

QLaunch v4.0

QLaunch v4.0 is a purchase upgrade to any pre v4.0 version of QLaunch, and can be installed over the top of your previous version as long as you had at least v2.9.9. To install, just disable your current version in the QLaunch main application menu, and then hotsync in your new version. Make sure to enable your new version after hotsync. In the About Menu, it should show up as v4.0.

NOTE: If you install QLaunch v4.0 over the top of a already registered pre -v4.0 version of QLaunch, then this new v4.0 will become unregistered, and you will have a 14 day unrestricted trial of the new features in v4.0

By the end of 14 days, you will need to purchase the upgrade, or re-install your old pre-4.0 version of QLaunch. If you purchase the upgrade, then you will be sent a new code. When you receive your upgrade code, go to the registration menu, and there should be an UPGRADE button there. Tap this button, then enter your upgrade code.

NOTE: If there is not an upgrade code there, but only a register button, then you will need to input your original registration code, and then the upgrade button will appear and you can then input the upgrade code to complete the registration process. If you ever have to re-install QLaunch for whatever reason, you will need to follow this process again.

New in QLaunch v4.1

The following new features have been added:

- Ability to launch applications stored on your memory card. Just enable the Allow VFS option in the preferences menu.
 - Toggle last app should also support toggling apps that were launched from the VFS card.
 - The application list has been cleaned up to only display applications that show up in the Launcher menu, and to not display hidden applications.
 - The PopUp Time special feature has been enhanced to also display your battery status as a percentage.

New in QLaunch v4.0

The following new special functions have been added:

- Toggle Handedness – This will toggle the LEFT, RIGHT Handedness setting on the Tungsten T3.
- Toggle Write on Screen – This will toggle the Graffiti2 on screen writing capability if your device supports it. This is very useful for the Tungsten T2, as it does not have the Virtual Graffiti area with the status bar like the T3 which allow you to easily toggle this feature.
- Toggle Virtual Graffiti – This will raise or lower your virtual graffiti area if the current application and your device support full screen mode.
- Toggle Landscape – This will toggle your display between Landscape and Portrait if your device supports it. Currently the T3 is the only one that supports this capability.

The following new preferences have been added:

Ignore the voice recorder key when the device is on. This is for people that accidentally keep pressing the VR button and getting dumped out of the application they are in.

VR = PageDown. This will also prevent you from getting dumped out of the application you are in, but instead of just ignoring the key press, it will turn the VR key press into a Page Down. The Page Down will be harmless to the application you are in, but it will be very useful when you are in an ebook reader like PalmReader as you can use this to scroll down while you are reading

New in QLaunch v3.5

- Fix bug on T3/TE when tapping REPORT button it would generate a RESET due to new Palm PIM Database on T3 and TE.
- New preference called "Enable after Reset". You get two choices, "Auto" and "Ask". These only work if QLaunch was enabled before the reset.
- Support for Garmin jog dial and select during QLaunch popup lists like in the popup specials list.
- New processing of what happens if you hold the keys a really long time. Before QLaunch did nothing until you let go of the key. Now if you get through the short, long, and longer flash, and keep holding the key for 1 more second, then QLaunch will perform the default function for that button. What good is this? Well before if you mapped anything to the address book, then you lost the hold address key for 2 seconds and beam business card feature. This has always bothered me. The default values for the short, long and longer are 1/2 second each, so that is 1.5 seconds for that, and then wait 1 second more and then the address book will launch, and start beaming your card. It may take longer than the default OS 2 seconds, but you can now map 3 extra things to that button, and still launch your business card. The same thing for the voice recorder, If you just hold the VR button for a little while longer after it goes through the flashes, then it will start recording a voice memo.
- Added Customizable popup specials list. You can have your own list of up to 10 instead of the list of 30+ special functions for "Popup Specials." Under Menus, there is a new CustomPrefs menu choice. This will bring up a list of the special functions so that you can choose your favorite list of up to 10 of them. To revert back to the entire list, then just deselect all the items from your custom list and you will have the full list again when executing PopupSpecials.

- Provide support for T2.
- Allow LED confirmation to just blink once for each short, long, or longer.

New in QLaunch v2.9.5

- McPhling MRU special function to pop-up the McPhling MRU list.

New features in V2.9

- Lock -- This will lock your Palm if you have a password set in the security Application.
 - Set AutoOff -- This will allow you to set your Auto Off time between 30 seconds and 2 hours. This is useful to help keep your auto off time at 30 seconds to save battery, but easily set it to 3 minutes while reading an e-book or some other activity.
 - Alpha Keyboard -- This is like tapping the Abc on the graffiti area. This is useful to bring up the keyboard in alpha mode, or to launch another keyboardtype hack like FatFinger that expects to see the Abc tapped.
 - Numeric Keyboard -- This is like tapping the 123 on the graffiti area. This is useful to bring up the keyboard in numeric mode, or to launch another keyboardtype hack that expects to see the 123 tapped.
 - Popup Time -- This will display the current time and date for ~2 seconds. This is especially useful for those who lock their device, as it will still display the time with the device locked.
 - Set AutoSilence -- This will bring up a menu that allows you to choose the amount of time you would like your sounds to be disabled for, and then it will automagically re-enable your sounds after the time you specify expires. This is useful if you are entering a meeting and do not want to be bothered or disturb others by alarms going off, but then you don't have to remember to re-enable your sounds after the meeting.
 - Toggle BlueTooth -- If you have V1.6 or greater of BtToggle installed, then executing this special function will allow you to toggle your BlueTooth radio.
