## Palm OS Basics

This manual assumes the user has knowledge of fundamental Palm OS concepts. If you are unsure how to run an application or other related concepts, please consult the user's guide that came with your communicator.

# Installation

## The xLights Package

The package should contain the following in the zip file:

- xLights Palm OS ".prc" file
- This Guide in PDF format
- Readme.txt file

Requirements:

- A Treo 270 or Treo 300 Communicator from Handspring

## Installing Your Software

To install xLights simply double-click the xLights.prc file or use the Palm Desktop Installer tool (usually located in Start/Programs/Palm Desktop/Install Tool)

If you are unsure how to install an application into your communicator, please consult the manual that came with it.

## About the Demo Version

The demo version of xLights is fully functional during the trial period of 15 days. After the trial period expires, xLights will automatically turn off. If you try to run xLights after this period, a trial expiration message will be displayed, and xLights will remain off until you register.

## Registering

If you decide to purchase xLights, you will need to enter your registration number obtained from <http://www.palmgear.com> to enable the software after the trial period.

# Using xLights

## Overview

xLights enables your keyboard backlight to turn on automatically whenever you press a key or tap the screen.

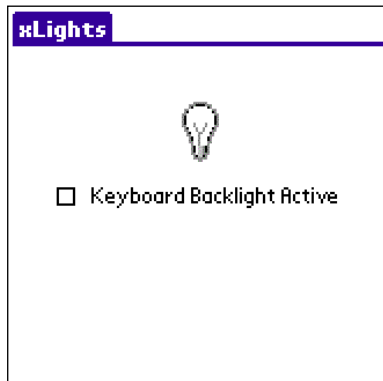
xLights enables/disables a feature known as Quick Typing Mode - every time you take some action your keyboard will turn on and remain on for at least 10 seconds. It will stay on as long as you are typing and for 10 seconds after you stop typing.

If turned off, xLights will have no effect.

## Turning xLights on and off



To turn xLights on, open the xLights application by tapping the menu to the right of the application's title and then check the "Keyboard Backlight Active" checkbox. The keyboard backlight will turn on immediately indicating that "Quick typing mode" is on.



To turn xLights off uncheck the "Keyboard Backlight Active" checkbox. The keyboard backlight will turn off immediately indicating that "Quick typing mode" is off.

# Frequently Asked Questions

## 1. What does xLights do?

xLights enables your keyboard backlight to turn on automatically whenever you press a key or tap the screen.

xLights enables/disables feature known as Quick Typing Mode - every time you take some action your keyboard will turn on and remain on for at least 10 seconds. It will stay on as long as you are typing and for 10 seconds after you stop typing.

## 2. How do I enable xLights?

Open the xLights application and check the "Keyboard Backlight Active" checkbox. The backlight will turn on immediately indicating that "Quick typing mode" is on.

## 3. How do I disable xLights?

Open the xLights application and uncheck the "Keyboard Backlight Active" checkbox. The backlight will turn off immediately indicating that "Quick typing mode" is off.

## 4. Backlight isn't working any more?

xLights has a trial period of 15 days. If your trial period has expired xLights will disable "Quick typing mode". Please visit us at <http://www.palmgear.com> and register to get a registration code.

Just install xLights again, open the application and uncheck the "Keyboard Backlight Active" checkbox. After this delete the xLights application.
