Thank you for purchasing this Wallpaper pack from RAINBOW MEIDA.

Compatibility

Wallpaper was developed and tested for **Windows Mobile PocketPC**.

Prerequisites

- Windows 98/ME/2000/ XP
- For Mac, unsupported, so unzip the exe file using the zip tools in windows
- Acitvesync 3.8 or greater

Unpacking the Wallpaper Pack

Our pack is supplied as a ZIP archive which contains set of jpg files. Downloaded file should be unpacked **on your desktop computer** to any temporary folder. You may use for that either regular WinZip or another unzip utility file, select any temporary folder and unzip it.

Installing new Wallpaper in the form of GIF / JPG file

GIF/ JPG files need to be installed manually on the phone. To install, please follow these steps:

For PocketPC and Windows Mobile 5 PocketPC

1. Click explore button in ActiveSync. Make sure that Activesync is connected.
2. Copy the GIF/JPG files into the folder \IPSM (Storage) \My Documents or Windows (Ref the Device User manual for the correct folder location).
3. To select the wallpaper for your "Today" screen, tap Start->Settings->Today and click on the appearance tab, then select the wallpaper following instructions on the screen.
4. Select the wallpaper you want from the image list and click OK

Uninstalling Wallpaper

To Uninstall or remove the image from the PocketPC, just delete the .jpg file in the PocketPC.




How to Change your Wallpaper

To switch the active Wallpaper from already installed Wallpapers, follow these steps:

1. From the Start Screen go to Start->Settings->Today.
2. Use the today setting to select your wallpaper. Tap the browse button to select the background image for today screen.
3. Select Done.
4. Press Home.
5. You will now see the new colors and background image in the Today Screen.

Troubleshooting / FAQs for Pocketpc:

Q1: I copied the wallpaper to my Pocket PC, and they don't show up on the Start | settings | Today screen | Appearance!

A1: The #1 reason for users who have this problem is that the image files (i.e. the .jpg files) are not copied DIRECTLY to the "My Documents" folder on the Pocket PC. Make sure that the copied .jpg files are in the "My Documents" folder of your PDA, and not under any sub-folders or the storage card. Otherwise, the wallpapers will not be recognized by the Today screen and will not appear in the settings menu. Don't

drag the whole "wallpapers" folder on your PC to "My Documents" on your PDA. Instead, go INSIDE the "wallpapers" folder and then select and copy the .jpg files.

Q2: I copied the JPG files in the Pocket PC's "My Documents" folder, but I cannot use them as Today wallpapers. Please help!

A2: Please make sure that you are having PocketPC / Windows Mobile Operating System Device.

Q3: I double-clicked on the .jpg files on my PC, but Windows does not know how to open the file.

A3: The .jpg wallpaper files must be copied to your Pocket PC's "My Documents" folder for them to work. Follow the steps in the "Installation" section of this document to install them.
