Introduction

Welcome

mCamLock is an application that disables the Treo built-in camera. It enables you to lock the Treo built-in camera for a specified amount of time.

During this time period, which you define before locking the camera, you will not be able to take new pictures or see previously recorded ones. When the time period expires, you will be able to restore the camera functionality.

There is no way to unlock the locked camera before the specified time period expires without completely destroying the content of your device, including all installed applications and data.

If you attempt to use the camera during the time when it is locked, the system will display an informational message clearly stating that the camera is disabled and showing the time remaining until the camera can be used again. You can show this message to the security officer before entering the environments in which the cameras are restricted, and use it as a proof that you will not be using your Treo camera inside such environments.

Palm OS Basics

This manual assumes the user has knowledge of fundamental Palm OS concepts. If you are unsure how to run an application or other related concept, please consult the user's guide that came with your communicator.

Installation

The mCamLock Package

The package should contain the following in the zip file:

- mCamLock Palm OS “.prc” file
- This Guide in PDF format

Requirements:

- Treo 650, Treo 700p, Treo 680, Treo 755p or Palm Centro communicator from PalmOne

Installing Your Software

To install an application transfer the .prc file to your device through a regular HotSync or by sending it to Palm device over Bluetooth or IR connection.

If you are unsure how to install an application on your communicator, please consult the manual that came with it.

Before installing mCamLock on your device, make sure that you have deleted any previous versions of mCamLock you may have.

Please ensure that the application resides in the main memory of the device and not on the SD card.

About the Demo Version

The demo version of mCamLock is fully functional during the 7 day trial period. After the trial period expires, mCamLock will disable its features and remain in that state until you activate it.

License activation

When you purchase mCamLock, the activation code will be sent to you via e-mail. **Please make sure that you have used the correct e-mail address during the purchase process.**

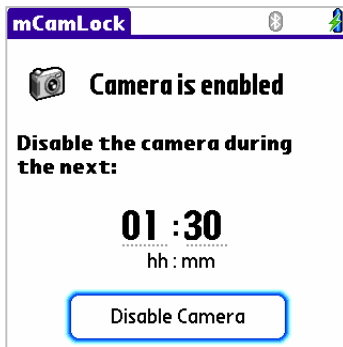
In order to activate mCamLock; start the application, select "Activate" option from the main menu and follow on-screen instructions.

Using mCamLock

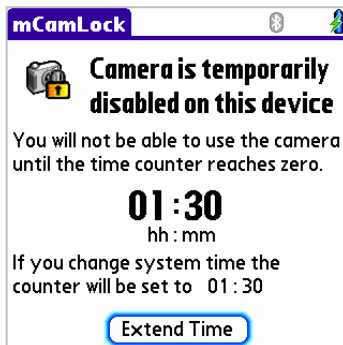
Overview

With mCamLock you can lock and disable your camera for a specified amount of time. During that time you will not be able to use the camera. Instead, the device will display an information message stating how much time is left before the camera can be used again.

Locking the Camera



To disable the Treo camera, enter the time in hours and minutes during which you want to disable it and tap the "Disable Camera" button.

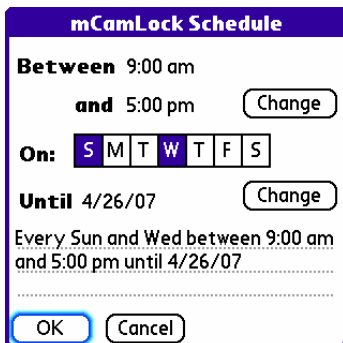


If you attempt to use the camera before the specified time elapses, the system will display a "temporary disabled"-message.

You can extend the time of camera locking by tapping on the Extend Time button.

When the specified time period elapses, you will be able to use your camera.

Using scheduler



You can setup scheduler to automatically lock your camera. Select "settings" from mCamLock menu and enter the time period during you want to disable the camera. Tap on the OK button to save settings.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. What does mCamLock do?

mCamLock enables you to lock the Treo built-in camera for a specified amount of time. During this time period, which you define before locking the camera, you will not be able to take new pictures or see previously recorded ones. When the time period expires, you will be able to use the camera functionality.

2. How can I enable camera before the defined time?

There is no way to enable the locked camera before the specified time period expires without completely destroying the content of your device, including all installed applications and data.

3. What will happen with the camera after the soft reset?

If you perform a soft reset your device while the camera is locked, it will remain locked.

4. What will happen if I change system time while camera is locked?

If you change system time while camera is locked it will lock again for amount of time that you specified when you lock the camera.

Troubleshooting

mCamLock normally does not require troubleshooting.
