Whether you are looking for an answer to your SysError Dialogs or to simply test your digitizer, Palm Doctor will complete your search for a more stable Palm. Requirements

Palm Doctor requires Palm OS compatible device, running at least version 2.0. You must have at least 80k of RAM or FlashROM available. There may be a need to disable any hacks, extensions, system patches, or drivers while running Palm Doctor. Of course like any application, it is preferred that you to backup your device before usage. For any additional information, see Legal Disclaimer.

Write Test

The Write Test performs complex multi database writes (MDBW), to examine your Palm for crashes due to hack and/or driver related conflicts. This test is not recommended under low battery conditions. If the Write Test fails it will report the Problem in the IPalm Doctor Report! memo log, explained later in the document.

Clipboard Test

The Clipboard Test was implemented into Palm Doctor due to various complaints of the system cut and pasting functions failing. The origin of these mysterious clipboard failures comes from clipboard modifying hacks. To ensure that you do not experience the frustration of a faulty clipboard, Palm Doctor will diagnose your systems most convenient functions (Copy, Cut, Paste, and Undo). If the Clipboard Test fails it

will report the Problem in the |Palm Doctor Report| memo log, explained later in the document.

System Test

The System Test is undoubtedly the most important test of the Palm Doctor arsenal. Stability & High Performance is important in Palm Computing, whether you are gaming, developing or organizing, stability is a must! There is nothing worse than a Hard Reset, even if you have backed your device up. It is such a hassle restoring or in most cases, starting over again. The System Test runs multi random System "calls", to verify potential conflicts/bus errors, with hacks, drivers, and patches. This test is not recommended under low battery conditions. If the System Test fails it will report the problem, in detail, in the |Palm Doctor Report| memo log, explained later in the document.

Digitizer Test

The Digitizer Test generates five "Tap Here" texts to the screen in random coordinates. If Three or more of these Tests fail, you will need to recalibrate your digitizer in the preference panel "Digitizer". This will be stated in the |Palm Doctor Report| memo log, explained later in the document.

Screen Test

The Screen Test verifies important elements of the display, Refreshment and rapid display. Rapid display includes basic text and graphics output. If the Screen Test fails it will report that Problem in the |Palm Doctor Report| memo log, explained later in the document.

Sound Test

The Sound Test verifies all system sounds and speaker output functions, It is a very effective test to define audio malfunction. If the Sound Test fails it will report that Problem in the |Palm Doctor Report| memo log, explained later in the document.

Tone Test

The Tone Test is in affiliations with the Sound Test. It detects any random frequencies values that may be off pitch. If the Tone Test fails or detects an off pitch frequency value, it will report that Problem in the |Palm Doctor Report| memo log, explained later in the document.

Each test, along with result(s), date, and time, will be documented in the built-in Memo Pad application -> Category Unfiled -> Memo Title |Palm Doctor Report|. Depending on user feedback, results possible will be saved as an independent DOC file upon user request/feedback. (Let me know)
