1.1 Licence

By using the enclosed program you agree with the following terms and conditions:

1) Transferring the unregistered version

Tamoggemon grants you the licence to distribute the unregistered version of this program via beaming or in binary form, as long as it doesn't get changed. When the executable is packed into an archive, Tamoggemon insists on the inclusion of at least Manual.pdf.

2) Registration

In the act of registration, Tamoggemon grants you the right to use PartyDice on one sole handheld at a time. In the event of device upgrade or hotsync name change, Tamoggemon Support will issue a new unlock key to you under the premise that all copies of the former key are destroyed irrecoverably and that the formerly registered version gets removed completely from the handheld!

3) Modification

Tamoggemon does not permit you to change or edit any of the files contained in this package. Changing also includes the opening of the file in editors as RsrcEdit with the intent of studying the internal architecture or theft of images/intellectual property!

4) Disassembly

Tamoggemon STRICTLY FORBIDS the intentional disassembly of the program, EVEN FOR INSTRUCTIONAL NEEDS!

5) Warranty

Tamoggemon can not, under any circumstances be held liable for damage caused by PartyDice. Also, there is no guarantee that the program will actually work on your handheld.

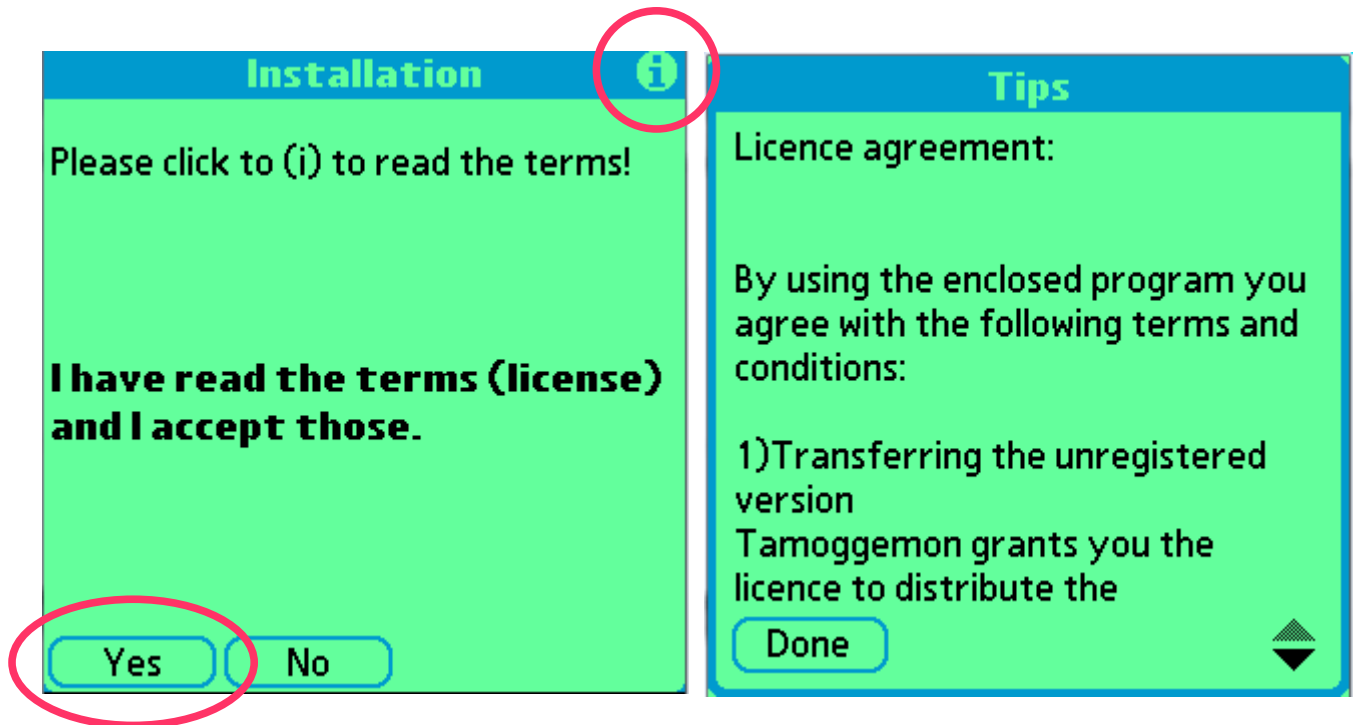

1.2 Installation

Install PartyDice on your Handheld or Smartphone as follows:

Put PartyDice on your Handheld or Smartphone the way you used to do with other PalmOS programs. If necessary, consult the manual of your Handheld concerning Hot Sync. In case of problems with the installation, please contact us (look at point 5.0 Contact). We'd like to support you.

Now start PartyDice on your Palm from Launcher ('Applications').



Please read the license and if you accept the license click on ' Yes'.

So far PartyDice has been tested on several implements without any failure. (Look at points 4.0/ 4.1), but we can't exclude possible complications.

The program will then announce that the installation process is completel. In case of failure please contact us.

2.0 Start a new game

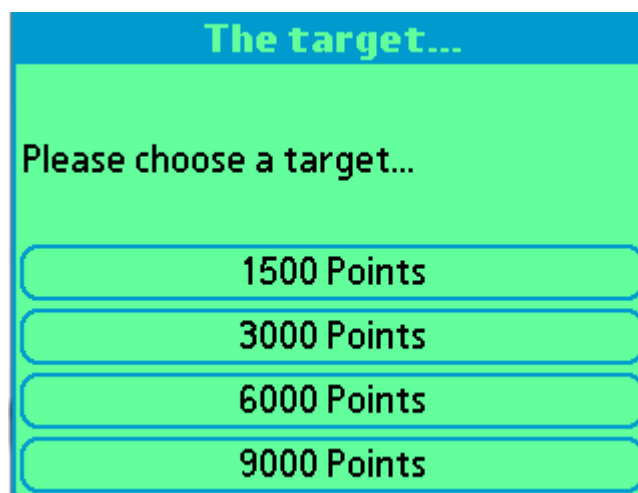


You can choose a game-mode here:

- 1 human and 2 virtual Players or
- 2 human and 1 virtual Player or
- only 3 human Players.

The 'virtual Players' are your PalmOS-Device.

2.1 Choose a game end (= target)



You can choose if the goal is

- 1500 Points
- 3000 Points (= Standard)
- 6000 Points
- 9000 Points

Info: The higher the target, the longer the game.

2.2 Choose a dice...



Here you can choose the look of the dices used by your alter ego. The 'virtual Players' have the grey dice, but you can give them a different dice to (Menu).

2.3 Typing in your name

Type in your name (into the field) and then click on the 'OK'-Button.
