User Documentation

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1. Introduction

Replace speed dial buttons with picture IDs. Quickly navigate the picture ribbon to the right picture and dial, launch application, compose a new email or sms.

With Picture Dial you can dial any phone number and launch any application in main memory. Add unlimited picture IDs to the Ribbon. Easy access by scrolling each page and find the correct picture.

No need to remember phone numbers again or what the person looks like. Just snap the picture with the camera application or use JPG picture and then use it in Picture Dial. You can even add weblinks, email and sms addresses to Picture Dial.

The most exciting add on for the Phone application for the Treo® 600/650 ever!

2. System Requirement

- Treo® 600/650
- 200K of free memory
- Treo® Phone application
- External SD card is required for the Treo®600 and is optional on the Treo® 650

2.1 Compatibility

- Treo® 600/650
- Treo® Phone application
- SD/MMC external cards
- Treo® Camera photos
- Bulter 3.5.1 and newer

3. Installation

To install Picture Dial™ you will need to install the following files and then press the HotSync® button on the cradle. The HotSync® manager will install the files on to your Palm.

You can double click on each file to put it into the Hotsync® queue or drag and drop all the files on the InstallTools or QuickInstall Window.

Note: All the files must be installed to main memory and cannot be installed on to the external card.

4. Launching Picture Dial™



To launch Picture Dial™, look for the icon **PictureDial** on the Treo® 650 or **PictureDial** on the Treo® 600 in the Launcher and tap on it.

4.1 Registering Picture Dial After You Purchased Picture Dial

After you have installed all files, launch Picture Dial and you will see the following screen.









You will need to write down your **HotSyncID** to use for generation of your Registration Code. Send your HotSyncID to support@toysoft.ca for your registration code.

When you get your registration code, launch the **Picture Dial** application again and enter the Registration C into the Reg Code: input area and tap "Register" button. You will only have to do this once.

5. User Interface

5.1 Creating a New Picture ID

To create a new Picture ID tap on the New button in the main screen.

Name: Jimmy, Wong

Type the display name. If you are adding a Voice Dial command then tap on the Lookup button to search for a contact in the Contacts database. Picture Dial will fill in the Name: field automatically.

Type: ▼ Dial Number

If you are adding a application Launch item then the application name will be filled in for you automatically after you have selected the application from the popup.

Select the type of picture id. Dial Number or Launch application

Phone Numbers: Lookup

If you are adding a Dial Number picture ID then you can use the Lookup to search the Contacts database. Picture Dial will display all the phone numbers associated with the contact.

You can then check the phone numbers you want to add to the picture ID or you use select

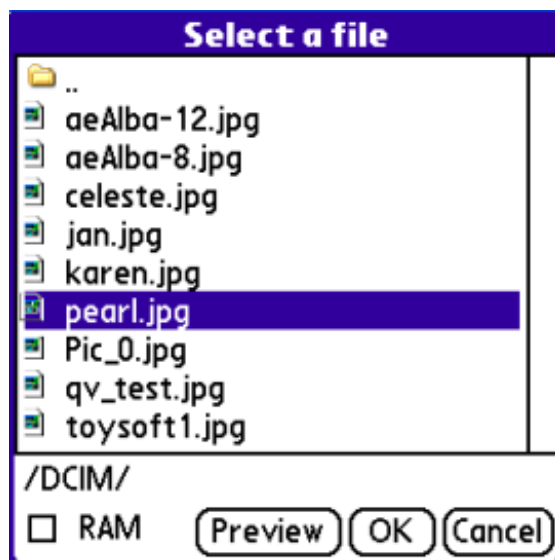


the Edit button to add your own number.

Tap on the button to select a JPG picture from the SD card. If you have your pictures saved in main memory then all you have to do is launch the Media application and then select the picture and export it to the SD card from the menu.

5.1.1 Selecting a Picture

You can use the file browser screen to browse the SD card or Internal memory on the Treo® 650 for the picture. Picture Dial only supports JPG format. **Progressive JPG format is not supported.**



By default Picture Dial looks in the DCIM folder on the SD card. If the picture is not in the folder you can use the previous icon .. to go to the previous folder.

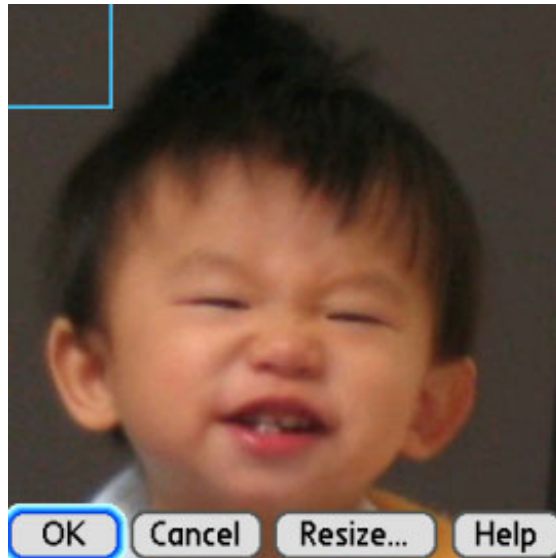
To look for the pictures on the Internal memory tap on the ☐ RAM checkbox. To switch back to the SD card uncheck the ☐ RAM checkbox. Internal memory is on for the Treo® 650

To preview the picture tap on the Preview button. When in preview mode tap on the screen to close the preview picture.

To select the picture tap on it and then select the OK button.

5.1.2 Editing a Picture ID

After you have selected a new picture id you will be in the edit screen. Here you select the region of the picture that you want to use as the picture id.

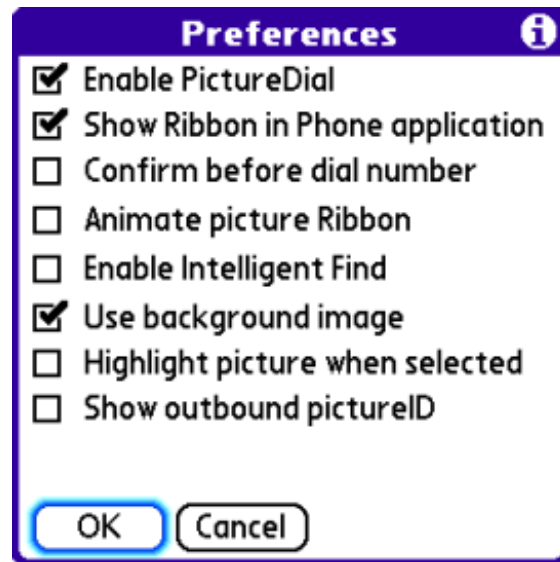


You must use the Stylus or use your finger to move the picture frame around the screen. The enclosed picture frame will be used as the picture id. You can tap on the Resize... button to resize the picture to a smaller manageable size.

5.2 Importing Favorite Buttons

To import phone numbers from the phone favorites database select Import Speed Dials from the Picture Dial menu. Picture Dial only imports phone numbers. After import is completed you will need to add your custom picture id. Picture Dial will use the default picture ID if there is no custom picture id assigned.

6. Preferences



☒ Enable PictureDial

Enable PictureDial checkbox must be checked.

☒ Show Ribbon in Phone application

If this is checked the Picture Ribbon will be show on the bottom of the Phone application. If you uncheck this feature you can then use the PicDialPics application to dial numbers and launch applications.

☐ Confirm before dial number

If you to confirm before the Phone application dials the number then check this checkbox.

☒ Animate picture Ribbon

If you want turn on cool animation for the picture Ribbon then check this checkbox.

☒ Enable Intelligent Find

If this is checked Picture Dial will lookup the picture id when you type the phone number on the keypad. When Picture Dial finds the closest match it will highlight it.

☒ Use background image

If this is checked a background image will be drawn behind the picture ids.

☒ Highlight picture when selected

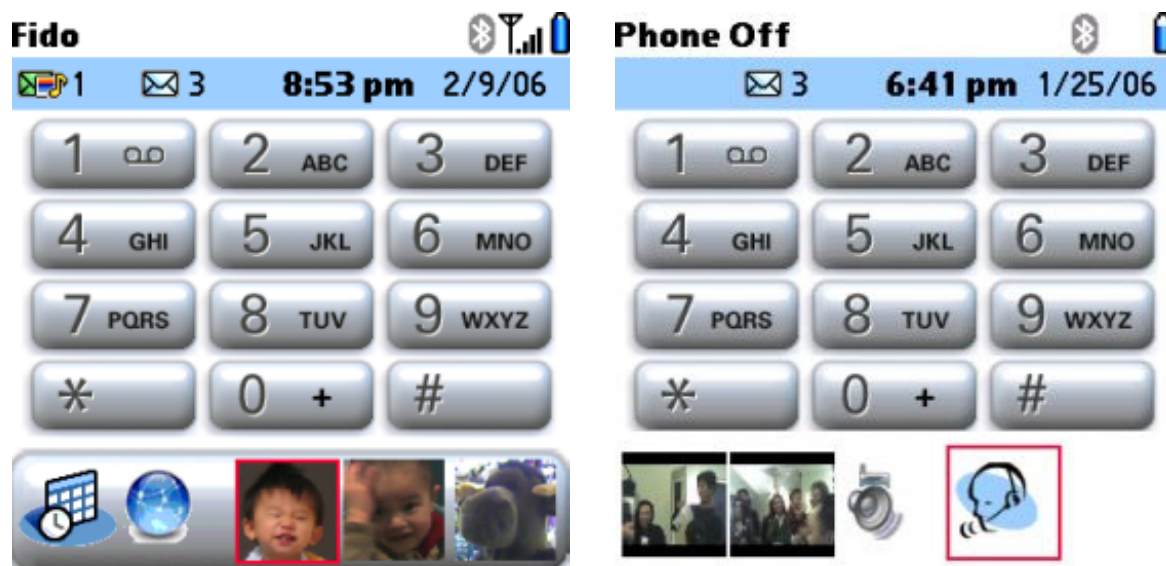
When you move left and right on the picture Ribbon there are two different ways to draw the selected picture id.

- Red box – If Highlight picture when selected is checked
- Blinking - Highlight picture when selected is unchecked then the picture id will be blinking.

☒ **Show outbound pictureID**

If this is checked and when you dial a contact in Picture Dial the picture id of the contact will be displayed on the calling screen.

7. Picture ID Ribbon



The Phone application on the Treo® 650 in 320x320 mode

Whenever you launch the Phone application you will see the Picture Dial Ribbon on the bottom of the screen.

You can use the 5 Way Left and Right keys to move the Highlight box left or right. Use the Up and Down keys to page up and page down the Ribbon.

5 Way Keypad and Key Shortcuts	Description
Left, Right	Move the highlight box left or right
Up, Down	Page up or down the Ribbon
Center	Dial the select phone number or launch the selected application
Screen Tap	To dial a phone number or launch a application you can tap on the picture id on the screen
ALT/Shift	Toggles PictureDial picture Ribbon and the Phone favorite buttons.

You can still use the phone keypad to dial any number as normally. When you press a number Picture Dial will use the Intelligent Find to match the number you are dialing with the picture ID database. When there is a match Picture Dial will highlight the picture ID.

Dial, Cancel and Clear Buttons

Since the Cancel, Dial and Clear buttons are not visible when the Picture Ribbon is shown you can use the backspace key on the keyboard to delete the digits that you have typed. To dial the phone number that you have typed you can press the Phone button key on the Treo® 650.

Phone Call Log File and Redial

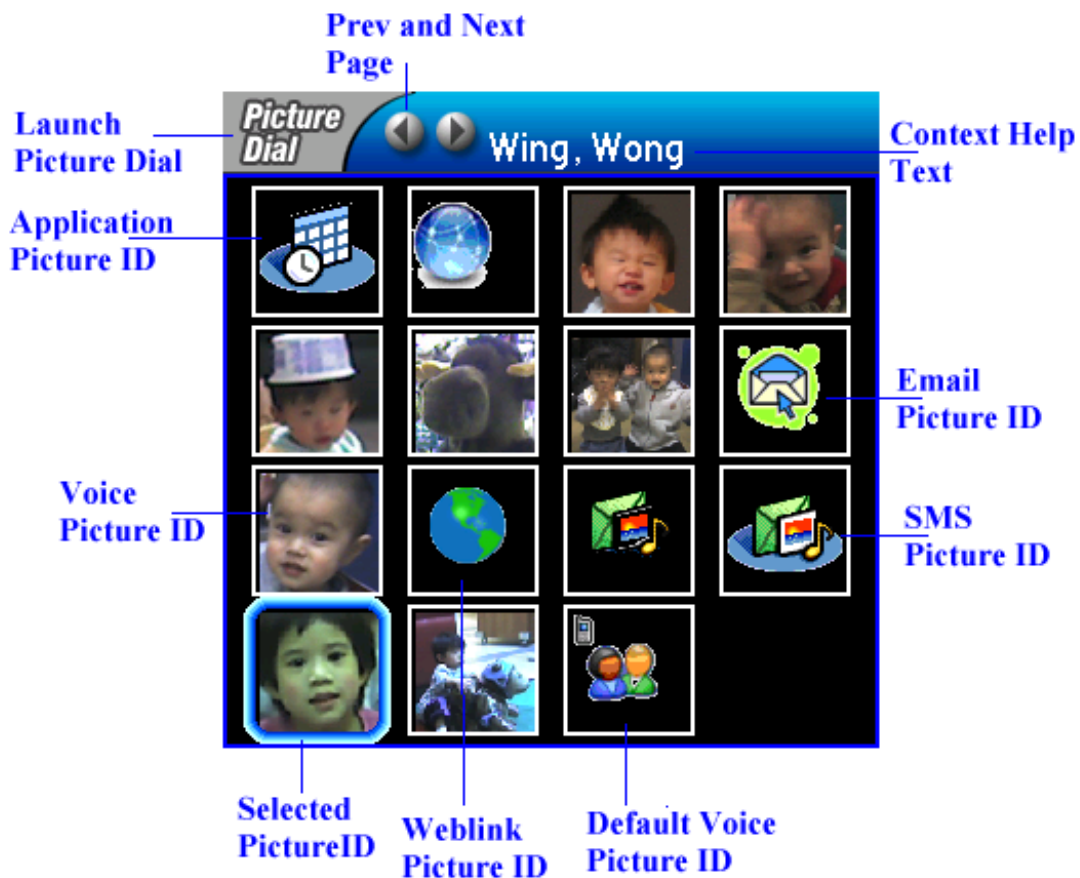
You can use the Phone key to bring up the call log and the recently dialed phone numbers. To redial the last phone number just press and hold the Phone key down.

8. Toggle Between PictureDial Ribbon and Phone Favorites



To toggle between PictureDial Ribbon and the Phone application's favorite buttons press the ALT or Shift key on the keyboard.

9. PictureDial Launcher Interface



Included with Picture Dial is the Picture ID plugin application that runs from the Launcher. The PicDialPics application gives you wider view of all the Picture Ids. You can easily select the picture id to launch.

By using the 5 way keys you can move the focus around the picture to see the context help text for that picture id. To dial or launch the picture id just press the Center button on the 5 way.

Use the Previous and Next arrow buttons to see more picture ids.

10. Outbound Picture ID

If you had checked to show outbound picture ID in the Preferences

☒ **Show outbound pictureID** then you will see the picture ID of the contact that you are trying to call on the call screen.



11. Picture Dial™ limitations

- Sometimes when your Treo® resets PictureDial may not be active in time to display the picture Ribbon. In this case just exit the Phone application and launch it again
- Progressive JPG is not supported
- Can not launch applications on the external card
- PictureID ribbon only works with the Treo® Phone application

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
